ReformedResources.org —the largest resource for Reformed teaching from nationally recognized pastors and theologians in the English-speaking world—is approaching 10,000 messages with more being added annually. Alliance Allies—a dedicated group of volunteers—are listening to many of these messages. Their work will play a big part of making this sound biblical teaching more easily accessible.



BECOME AN ALLIANCE ALLY

The Alliance has a rich treasury of sermons throughout our 75 year history. We want these messages to have maximum impact on the Church for future generations. One of our goals is to construct a reliable and searchable database that is easily accessible to our supporters and listeners.

To achieve this goal, we have developed a core group of volunteers called Allies. Currently numbered at 45, Alliance Allies review sermons and provide info on the major themes, main points, and key words that help us identify and summarize each message. Working in teams of 8, they reviewed 14 complete sermon series in 2024! We have started three new series so far in 2025. When each reviewer completes work on a series, they receive a book or booklet as a thank-you.

Now that we have enough data points on the sermons already reviewed, we can begin the work of assimilating and synthesizing the reviews to attain consensus and populate the database. This will give people the ability to access sermons based on themes and key words.

We are looking for volunteers to help us accomplish this project. Alliance Allies will listen to sermons, complete a simple review form, and return the form digitally or in a postage-paid envelope. - Marshall resources to strengthen the Church




